The Lower Lehigh Lions Club will hold its Fall Flea Market and Garage Sale on Saturday September 11, 2010 at the Macungie Memorial Park. Spaces will be available for setting up beginning at 6:00 AM with the sale beginning at 8:00 AM and going until 2:30 PM. Last year we had well over 150 vendors.

A registration form is included as part of this letter for your convenience in reserving a space. The spaces are 15' X 25' and are \$15.00 for the day. We provide space only. You need your own tables, etc. Space is limited. Please get your reservations in early. If you would care to reserve a space, please complete the form and mail it along with your check to the **Lower Lehigh Lions Club, c/o Ronald Bechtel, 429 E. Main St, Macungie, Pennsylvania, 18062**. Please make your check **payable to the Lower Lehigh Lions Club. Payment is due with reservation. Cancellation with a refund must be made at least 10 days prior to the flea market. Rain Date: Sunday September 12, 2010. Postponing to the rain date is at the discretion of the committee. No credit if we need to use our rain date.**

At recent sales a number of persons were displaying items outside of the staked area of their lots. We are asking that you confine your displays within the assigned area, as the walkways must be free for pedestrian and emergency vehicle traffic.

On September 11, 2010 we are asking that you use the Poplar Street entrance, this is the entrance from Route 100/Main St. Members of the Lions Club will be waiting there to assist you in locating your assigned space. The Lions will be operating the refreshment stand, so we ask that you **do not** sell food or drink from your stand. Breakfast sandwiches will be available from 6:30 to 9:30 or while supply lasts. Hot sandwiches will be available from approx. 9:30 until at least 12 noon but **no later than 1:30 PM**. Drinks will be available while we do our clean up. Remember, we were also here at 6 AM.

At past flea markets, a number of large unsold items and tires were left for us to dispose of. Please, if you bring items that remain unsold at the end of the day, take them with you. We are trying to reduce the trash pick-up, costs, and the inconvenience to the park caused by overloading their dumpsters.

If you have knives for sale, please do not sell them to any children or teenagers unless a parent accompanies them. No firearms are to be sold. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in helping us comply with current safety measures.

The Lions will again be running a 50/50 drawing at the flea market to support a sight related charity. 50% will go to the charity, 20% to 1st place winner, 10% to 2nd and 3rd place winners, 5% to 4th and 5th place winners. The drawing will be at approx. 2 PM and winner need not be present. At our spring flea market we made \$319.00; \$159.50 went to our free eye exam and eyeglasses school program and \$159.50 to the lucky 5 winners. Chances will be a donation of \$1 or 6 for \$5 and will be available at the Lioness space, next to the refreshment stand, and our Lions area. Thank you for your support in spring and we look forward to your continued support this fall. Please help support this worthy sight effort.

Reminder: we hold checks until after the flea market. I will acknowledge receipt of your check if I have an email address. *Unfortunately this past year we had several checks that bounced. This is not only embarrassing to you but creates extra work for us. Please be sure we have your current checking account and that sufficient funds are available. Thank you.*

The Spring Flea Market will be held on Saturday May 7, 2011.

The Lower Lehigh Lions Club collects used eyeglasses, hearing aids, and hearing aid batteries. Please bring any you may have with you and we will collect them as we walk around. We also collect non-perishable food items for the local food bank.
