- Worldwide Fundraising Goal - \$52,000,000 US (official goal) - CA 1 goal of \$7,279,389
- Chairman/IPIP Brian Sheehan's goal \$70,000,000 US; stretch goal of \$75,000,000 US
- Area B - \$924,777 (official goal); Chairman Brian's goal \$1,233,036 (**\$36 per member average**)

GOALS

1. No later than Aug 31, 2023, each club shall appoint an LCIF Coordinator and report it to LCI with their club officers.

- IF your club has not reported their LCIF coordinator by 8/31/23, I will be contacting the club president or secretary and request that they name a coordinator or appoint the immediate past president as coordinator. Where no club coordinator is appointed, the club president should be selected as your contact point for the club.
- An LCIF Coordinator Orientation or Training will be announced on what LCIF is, however we can support their clubs and districts through grants and programs such as Lions Quest, and let them know the fundraising goals for LCIF, including the amount their club is requested to contribute (\$36 per member average). 14K Club balances, past grants, grant information, contribution history, etc can be obtained if needed. 2. Fundraising goals -

- 100% of leadership shall contribute to LCIF. This includes Club LCIF Coordinators, District Governors, VDG, PDG, GAT team members. We lead by example. (If we do not contribute, how can we ask others to do so?)
- We will grow our number of clubs participating by 10% this year with a minimum expected contribution of \$100 per club.
- We will grow the number of individual member contributions by 50% (stretch goal of 100%) this year. This includes all contributions from individual members no matter how large or small. All individual contributions are to be reported as such to LCIF. Use the Multiple Donor Contribution Form to list each individual donor.
- Clubs and districts will run fundraisers for LCIF throughout the Lions year.
- LCIF displays, literature, and LCIF information will be prominently displayed at all Club Visitations, District Rallies, and District Conventions. Fundraisers should be considered for each event.
