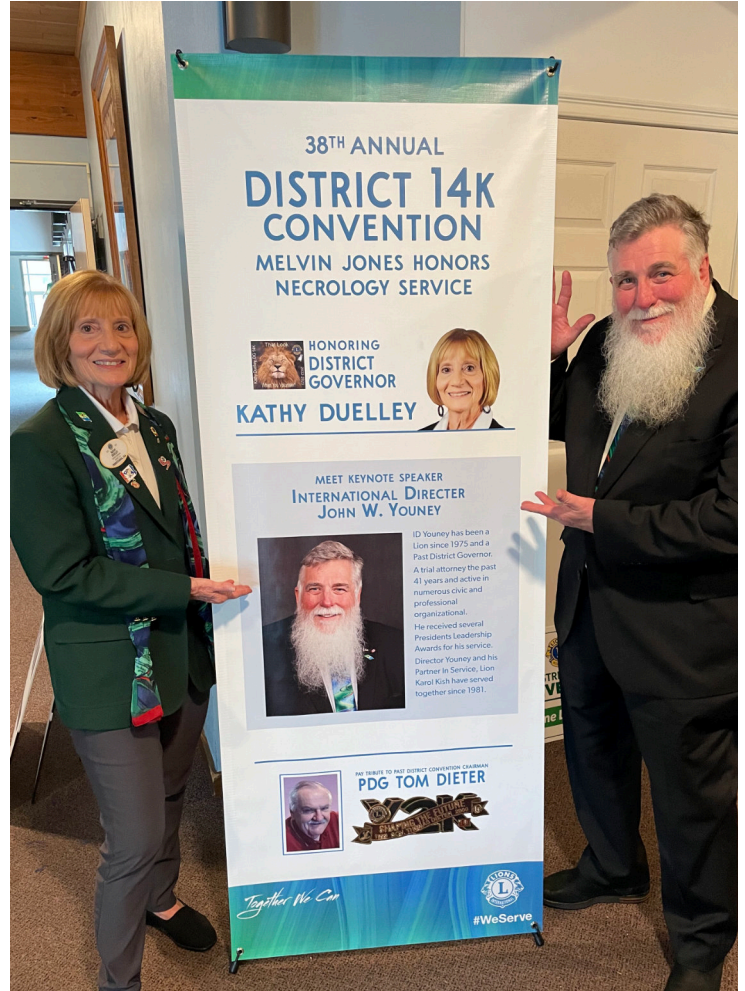

JOURNEY FOR SIGHT WALK SATURDAY MAY 6TH LEHIGH VALLEY MALL

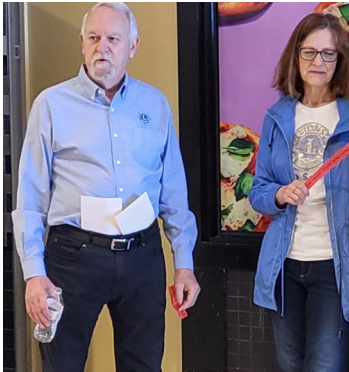

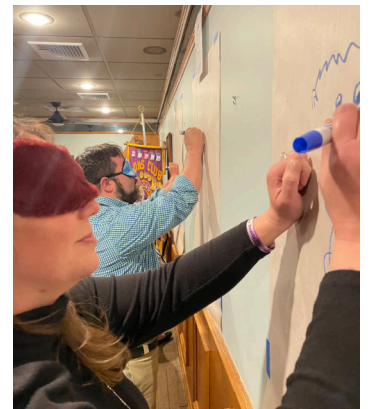
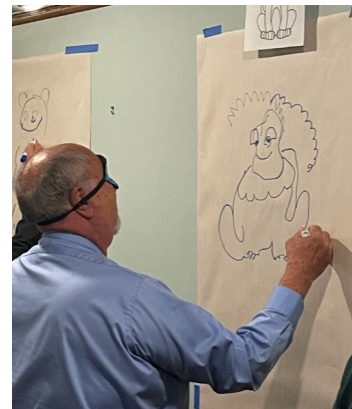

If you missed the District 14k Convention and were wondering. Well here are the answers to our District 14k “Guess Who” contest.

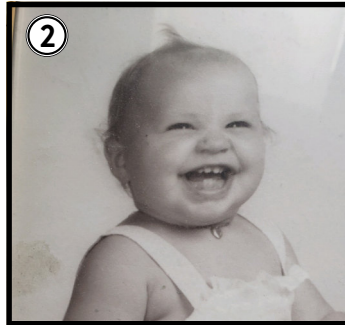
We received many entries with some interesting guesses.

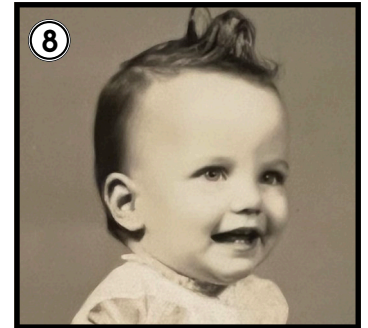
