











- NEW BUDGET for 2020-2021 create one
- <u>PLAN</u> your fundraiser events and service activities: communicate to your members
- MEMBERSHIP DRIVE schedule one for 2020-2021
- <u>MEMBERSHIP RETENTION</u> (every member matters) create a program and/or member orientation refresher
- <u>FUTURE LEADERS</u> promote within your Club
- <u>DISTRICT ACTIVITIES</u> participate!
- BOWL-A-THON 2020 reminder to submit 40% pledge monies to 1VDGE Debbie Lillegard (Emmaus L-L); make checks payable to Lions D-14K.
